What's it all about?

On Saturday 18th June 2011, a band of brave, mad fools are planning to ride classic scooters – that's Vespa's and Lambretta's - 1664 miles across Great Britain to raise money for charity! Starting at John O'Groats in the northern tip of Scotland to Lands End in Cornwall and returning to Ashford via Brighton and Beachy Head. It will take around 11-12 days in total. The departure event is The White Cliffs Weekender in Deal, Kent and the return event is Camber Sands Rally Near Rye in Sussex, where Chelmsford Scooter Club are donating the proceeds of the Rally's raffle. The charity is Find A Voice which helps and supports people of all ages with speech, language and communication difficulties. Celebrity support comes from Jan Francis the actress and Damian Green the government minister as well as support from local radio and BBC radio who will be featuring daily progress of the ride. Together we'd like this to be a genuinely UK-wide event and we invite all clubs and scooterists to join along the way for photo opportunities and riding. - a who's who of UK scooter clubs. We already have the support of many clubs, some are holding nights of scooter sounds and other fund raising benefits, some will be meeting us on the last leg of our ride etc. Full details including the route and how to contact us can be found on our website www.longscotdown.co.uk Help us to show the whole UK what we scooter enthusiasts can do!
